<i>Academic Year Structure</i>	The academic year 2018/2019 starts on 1st October 2018 and lasts until 30th September 2019. The academic year is divided into two terms. <b>I. The winter semester:</b> The classes start on 1st October 2018 and last until 1st February 2019. Important dates: ◦ 24 December 2018 – 6 January 2019 – Christmas break ◦ 4 - 15 February 2019 – winter examination period, <b>II. The spring semester:</b> The classes start on 25st February 2019 and last until 21 June 2019. Important dates: ◦ 18 - 24 April 2019 – Easter break ◦ 24 June - 5 July 2019 – spring examination period.

<i>Application procedure</i>	<p>If you want to study as Erasmus student at Vincent Pol University, you should first contact the Erasmus coordinator at your home university, and ask to be nominated. Fill Erasmus Application Form and print it. Confirm Erasmus Application Form with the stamp and the signature of your home Erasmus coordinator. Complete applications should be sent by email to the ERASMUS inbox listed above. Emailed applications are acceptable and there is no need to send hard copies. All applicants should include a recent Academic Transcript with their application document.</li> </ol> <p><i>Acceptance documents will be sent by email from the International Relations Office when applications have been approved by the relevant department.</i></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>2. Contact with your home Erasmus coordinator and with the VPU Erasmus coordinator to prepare or consult your Learning Agreement. Send your LA to the departmental coordinator.</li> </ol> <p>Please remember to consult with the departmental Erasmus coordinators from your home University (sending university) and from Vincent Pol University (receiving university) and send them Learning agreement for their confirmation.</p>
<i>Language Requirements</i>	Students should have at least level B1 in the language of instruction. No formal test required from ERASMUS students - confirmation by home institution is sufficient.
<i>Polish language courses</i>	We offer FREE Polish language support courses, running for 1-2 hours per week for 15 weeks.
<i>Accommodation</i>	The International Relations Office assists with finding accommodation in dormitories.
