All study programmes at the University of Cologne are structured into modules.
A module is a teaching unit consisting of several co-requisite courses (e.g. 1
lecture + 1 seminar + 1 tutorial) that must be taken together and one final exam
,
(written, oral, or combined). Depending on the module's size and workload, stu-
dents are awarded 6 to 15 ECTS points.
