Application procedure	1. Exchange students are nominated by their home university. The nomination should include the following information: - name and surname of the nominee - date of birth - e-mail - sex - field of study/academic area - level of study 2. Exchange students are invited to fill in and email to UJK the application documents: - Incoming Student Exchange Application Form - Foreign Student Accommodation Application Form - Polish Language Course Application Form (optional but advisable) Exchange students will also need to email: - a copy of passport ID page or a copy of Identity Card (valid for the period of stay at UJK) - a copy of health insurance - official photo of the participant 2cm x 2.5cm jpg, 236 x 295 pixels. 3. After all documents are submitted, exchange students receive the letters of acceptance.
